OLD BUSINESS- Turkey Supper - more volunteers are needed for dishwashing, help was very limited. Carry out went well, both take out lines were left open longer. NEW BUSINESS- Jesus Birthday party - Rhonda Meyer will organize this special event and get the needed supplies. Cupcakes will be ordered for grades K - 5<sup>th</sup>, and Preschool and Pre-K will have donuts for their celebration. School Carnival - Carnival Committee will be meeting on November 28<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 pm. Anyone that would like to be involved in helping organize this event is welcome to come to the meeting on Nov. 28<sup>th</sup> at St. Paul School. Your help is needed! Profit request - continue with adding technology in class rooms, would like to have more technology installed over the Summer so it is ready for the 2012 school year. Technology still needed consists of projectors, better quality speakers for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> grades(audio cord may be the solution to this problem) cord will be purchased, universal TV/VCR remote is needed. Mrs. Carnes would like to see some equipment purchased for physical fitness, chin up bar and stability balls were some of the suggestions. This equipment would be very useful especially during the Winter months. Amy Southwick will check on some prices. Staff will let PTL know if help is need with funding.
